## Masonic Scholarship Application

Lombard Lodge No. 1098, A.F. & A.M., located at 383 E. Lake St, Bloomingdale, IL 60108, will be awarding scholarships to a number of high school seniors and/or college students this academic year from a high school within the State of Illinois or IL State resident attending college. The exact dollar amount of each scholarship will depend upon the size of investment income and donations to the Lombard Lodge Scholarship Fund. Several scholarships ranging from \$500 to \$1000 each have been paid out to eligible students each year. These scholarships are intended to assist students pursuing postsecondary education in any state at an accredited institution, including two- or four-year colleges, universities, or accredited trade, technical, or vocational schools. Scholarship funds may be used for any bona fide school-related expense, including tuition, fees, books, and required educational materials.

Applicants need not have a Masonic connection, nor do race, creed, religion, color, sex, or national origin have any bearing in the selection process. Recipients are selected after completing a comprehensive written application and an in-depth personal interview.

A broad-based criteria is used in the selection process. The principal criterion is service to school and community with special emphasis upon leadership roles in these areas. Lombard Lodge No. 1098, A.F. & A.M. is looking for those students who exhibit the greatest potential to be not only of service to their communities in the future but also leaders in these communities. An applicant's academic record, communication skills, and need for financial assistance are also carefully considered as is an evaluation of the applicant by a school official. The organization, appearance, and completeness of the application are also factors considered by the Scholarship Committee.

From all the applications received, the Scholarship Committee will select a number of finalists who will be asked to appear before the committee for a personal interview. These interviews will be conducted at a location and time determined by the scholarship committee. Upon completion of the interviews, the committee will then select those who will receive scholarships.

High school seniors or college students who feel they meet the criteria for eligibility and selection are invited to submit applications. These applications may be obtained through the Lombard Lodge website or member of Lombard Lodge and must be postmarked no later than May 1, 2026 for the application
